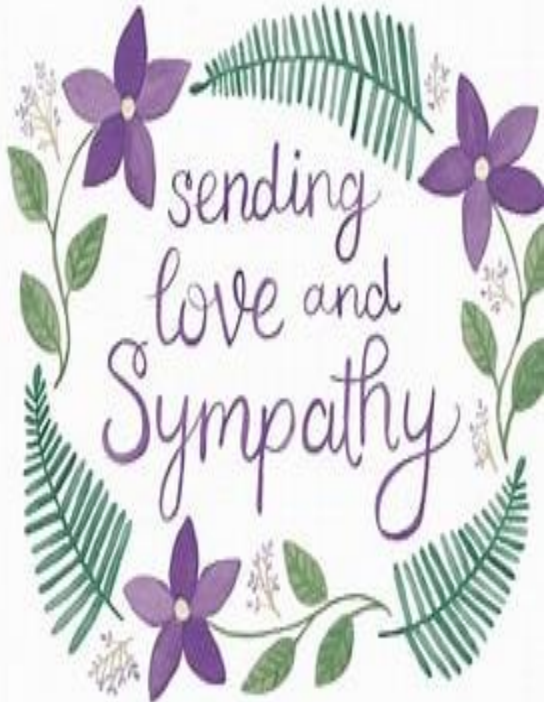

Go to wswconnect.com or download the Westwood Shores Connections app located in either the Play Store or App Store.

For web viewing NO LOG IN is REQUIRED for general information. But if you want to read notifications login is required as a Westwood Shores owner.

- **USERNAME**= last name first name address street number i.e. smithjoe110
- **PASSWORD**= changeme

Username and password must all be lowercase.

Initial login successful you will be prompted to create your own password. Remember NO ONE can retrieve it for you.

Want notifications to popup to notify you have a message you must use the app.

Login is the same for web or app access.

House Numbers are Required by POA Policy. Numbers must Be Legible From the Street

Every house has an assigned identifying number that displays your home address. Although these numbers are important for the mailman and guests visiting you, house numbers are crucial for emergency personnel when responding to the location of an emergency.

When 911 is called to report an incident or emergency, dispatchers receiving the call have a key job to do by determining where the emergency is taking place. The call takers must then relay the location to the proper emergency responder such as law enforcement, the fire department, or ambulance. While emergency personnel are responding to the location of the incident, they are relying on accurate information from the dispatcher to ensure that they are going to the correct address.

Hummingbirds are filling up at our bird feeders before heading south! Peak migration leaving Indiana will be during the next 2-3 weeks.

The color bands roughly indicate the peak timeline of when most species of hummingbirds will be leaving your area.(below) Although, there will still be stragglers until Halloween, so keep your feeders full until then!

According to Journey North, males leave first, then the females, then eventually followed by the new chicks / young. They are not guided by their parents, but rather use instincts to get to their winter homes in Central and South America.

The newly born hummingbirds need more time to fill up and strengthen before the long journey south.
