GARBAGE SCHEDULE

HOUSEHOLD TRASH PICKUP: Tuesday pickup. All Trash must be bagged in a flip lid trash can. Loose trash will not be picked up. Can needs to be at curb by 7:30 am. Can needs to be pulled back to house by end of day.

ALL CARDBOARD: Whether **picked up at curb on first Monday of the month** or dropped off, must be emptied of packing material, flattened and tied or taped together.

CARDBOARD AND VEGATATION DROP OFF: Every Wed and Sat 8:00-Noon (Location in last paragraph of this text box.)

HEAVY HAUL CURB PICK UP: Curb pick twice a year after garage sale! **September** starts on the **28th till completed**. Comes by each house once October Drop off: Saturday Oct 3rd & 17th

REMEMBER HEAVY LARGE ITEMS HAVE A FEE TO DUMP, CALL THE POA OFFICE FOR DETAILS AND PAY IN ADVANCE

Westwood Shores POA Hunting Orientation

Westwood Shores POA Subdivision will be conducting a controlled management archery hunt every Friday, Saturday, and Sunday during the morning and evening. The managed hunt will start on October 3, 2026, to January 3, 2027, with a goal of 50 deer harvested from our ever-growing population of white tail deer herd. From October 3, 2026, to November 29, 2026, no antlerless permit required. A bag limit of two bucks, (either one buck and one spike or you can harvest two spikes with no buck), and two does can be harvested for the management of the deer population. The following are basic rules and procedures:

GOAL: Removal of 50 deer by a means of a controlled archery hunt.

For web viewing NO LOG IN is REQUIRED for general information. But if you want to read notifications login is required as a Westwood Shores owner.

- **USERNAME**= last name first name address street number i.e. smithjoe110
- **PASSWORD**= changeme

Username and password must all be lowercase.

Initial login successful you will be prompted to create your own password. Remember NO ONE can retrieve it for you.

Want notifications to popup to notify you have a message you must use the app.

Login is the same for web or app access.
