BIG D Classic 2026: Record-Breaking Growth and Unforgettable Memories The 2026 Big D Classic was our largest and most successful tournament to date. What began with just 13 teams in 2024 has grown into an impressive 46-team field (92 golfers) in 2026 — clear proof of the event's rising popularity and the strong support it continues to receive.

Golfers traveled from across Texas and beyond, representing a wide range of hometowns including College Station, Crockett, Fairfield, Houston, Livingston, Lufkin, Austin, Huntsville, Dallas, Conroe, Normangee, and Elkhart. Additional participants make the trip from Tennessee and New Mexico. This diverse turnout beautifully reflects the tournament's expanding reach and its ability to bring golfers together from many different communities.

By the Numbers • 46 Teams competed in the record-breaking field • 92 Golfers took part in the competition • 110 Guests enjoyed the pre-tournament dinner. The tournament generated \$22,966.47 in total revenue for Westwood Shores. More importantly, the weekend was filled with positive energy and heartfelt feedback. Participants and attendees praised the smooth organization, excellent course conditions, delicious food, and the welcoming overall experience. These compliments speak volumes about the reputation the Big D Classic has built.

Looking Ahead The remarkable growth from 13 teams in 2024 to 46 teams in 2026 is a true testament to the dedication of our players, sponsors, volunteers, and staff. We are sincerely grateful to everyone who participated and helped make this year's event such a tremendous success. We look forward to building on this momentum and making next year's Big D Classic even bigger and better.
